During the coming growing season the following list of products may be used to maintain your lawn and landscape. Provided is a summary of the applicable label precautionary statements, which NexGreen and the Maryland Department of Agriculture have developed, relating to the dilute forms of products which may be used to prevent or reduce damage from certain lawn and landscape pests. To determine exactly which products were used, please refer to the information provided by your NexGreen Specialist, following each service visit.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison center or doctor for treatment advice. If swallowed, call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. If inhaled, move person to fresh air call Poison Control Center at (800)222-1222 or doctor for treatment advice.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS/ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

LAWN CARE

- ***2,4-D+MECOPROP+DICAMBA** - Do not allow people (other than applicator) or pets on treatment area during application. Do not enter treatment areas until spray has dried. Reseed no sooner than three to four weeks after application of this product.
- **FENOXAPROP+FLUROXYPYR+DICAMBA** - Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates.
- ***MCPA+FLUROXYPYR+TRICLOPYR** - Drift or runoff may adversely affect non target plants. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. Do not enter treatment areas until spray has dried.
- ***BIFENTHRIN** - Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Do not allow people or pets on treated surfaces until spray had dried.
- **CLOTHIANIDIN** - Causes moderate eye irritation. Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through skin or inhaled. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid breathing sprayed mist. Only protected workers may be in the area during application.
- **DITHIOPR** - Do not use clippings from treated turf for mulching around vegetables or fruit trees. Do not graze livestock or feed forage cut from areas treated with this product.
- **FENOXAPROP-ETHYL** - Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. Acclaim Extra Herbicide may be applied to newly plugged zoysiagrass. Fescues and ryegrass may be over-seeded immediately following Acclaim Extra Herbicide applications. All other turf species should be over-seeded after a 21 day waiting period.
- **GLYPHOSATE** - Keep people and pets off treated areas until spray solution has dried to prevent transfer of this product onto desirable vegetation.
- **TRICHLORFON** -Do not breathe dust, avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. This product is toxic to fish, birds and wildlife.
- **IMIDACLOPRID** - Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Keep children and pets off treated area until spray is dry. This product is highly toxic to aquatic invertebrates. This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on blooming crops and weeds. Do not graze treated areas or use clippings from treated areas for feed or forage.
- **FLORASULAM**- Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present.
- **MYCLOBUTANIL** - Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing Keep unprotected persons out of treated area until sprays have dried.
- ***PRODIAMINE** - Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Do not graze or feed livestock forage from areas treated with Barricade.
- **QUINCLORAC** - Do not enter or allow others to enter the treated area until sprays have dried. Do not use clippings as mulch or compost around flowers, ornamentals, trees or in vegetable gardens.
- **SULFENTRAZONE** - Reseeding, over-seeding or sprigging of treated area within one (1) month after application of this product could inhibit the establishment of desirable turf grasses.
- **TRICLOPYR** - Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Avoid breathing mist or vapors. This pesticide is toxic to fish.
- **Iron HEDTA**- Causes slight eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals

TREE & SHRUB CARE

- ***ABAMECTIN** -Do not breathe spray mist. Avoid contact with skin. This pesticide is toxic to fish and wildlife. This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on blooming crops or weeds. Do not enter treated areas until sprays have dried.
- ***BIFENAZATE** - This pesticide is toxic to fish. This product is toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on blooming crops or weeds.
- ***BIFENTHRIN** - Avoid breathing spray mist. This pesticide is extremely toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates. This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on crops or weeds.

- **CYFLUTHRIN** - Avoid breathing dust or spray mist. Do not allow children or pets to enter treated area until surfaces are dry. This pesticide is toxic to fish. This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on crops or weeds.
- **DINOTEFURAN** - Do not graze treated areas or use clippings from treated areas for feed or forage. Keep children and pets off treated areas until spray has dried. Keep children and pets off treated areas until dusts have settled.
- **GLYPHOSATE** - Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Keep people and pets off treated areas until spray solution has dried to prevent transfer of this product onto desirable vegetation.
- ***HEXYTHIOZOX** - Avoid breathing dust or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates.
- ***HORTICULTURAL OIL** - Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. This product is toxic to fish.
- ***ACETAMIPRID** - Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. Keep children and pets off treated areas until dry.
- ***MYCLOBUTANIL** - Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Keep unprotected person out of treated area until spray have dried.
- **PROPICONAZOLE**- Do not graze animals on treated area. Do not feed clippings from treated areas to livestock or poultry. This pesticide is toxic to fish.
- **SPIROMESIFEN**- Harmful if swallowed inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates.
- ***FLUPYRADIFURONE**-Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Do not apply directly to water or areas where surface water is present.

EXTERIOR PEST CONTROL

- ***BIFENTHRIN** - Avoid breathing spray mist. This pesticide is extremely toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates. This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on crops or weeds.
- **PYRIPROXYFEN**- Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates.
- **LAMBDA-CYHALOTHRIN**- Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates. Highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on blooming crops or weeds.
